

Attollo Recruit is our 5:30 AM onboarding process, which is an intensive 6-week course that begins at 5:30 AM. We partner with school districts who recruit a diverse cohort of high school juniors to be part of the program.

During the six weeks of Attollo Recruit, potential scholars experience the meaning of our pillars: Strong Mind, Competition, Resiliency, Accountability, Sacrifice, and Finish Strong. Students are able to take time of radical self-inquiry, as well as have the opportunity to learn how to solve the Rubik's cube in less than 90 seconds.








JUNIOR YEAR

COLLEGE PREP & CAREER READINESS

Upon completion of the Recruit program, scholars have access to a suite of exploratory and college-prep programs: Attollo Coding, Attollo Studios, Attollo Medicine, Attollo Start-Up, and SAT Prep.

In these courses, our facilitators incorporate college-level materials and allow scholars to explore their career through internships and professional development projects













YEAR ROUND SAT

The Attollo SAT program is designed to ensure that our scholars reach their full potential. Our goal is for no scholar to score under 1000 points on the test and for every scholar to experience a one hundred point increase from their base scores. To achieve this goal we offer programs that provide subject tutoring, test strategies, and practice exams. We want all of our scholars to attend the school of their dreams and a high SAT score is an essential part of the plan.

ATTOLLO ENGINEERING

Our Attollo Engineering and Code program aims to increase access and exposure to the STEM field and provide opportunities to a diverse group of students.

ATTOLLO PRE-MED

Pre-Med is focused on exposure and inspiration for future healthcare workers. Local health professionals from various fields are recruited to teach as mentors. Each AMed Scholar will have one 4+ hour shadowing experience with a clinician of their choice. Students will present a career action plan developed under the guidance of their professional mentor.

ATTOLLO STUDIOS

Our creative program aims to help our students practice telling their stories through creative problem-solving while preparing a compelling portfolio for their college applications. Not only are we focusing on creating content, but we will also focus on professional practices and presentation skills.

ATTOLLO STARTUP












Kicking off the year with Senior Sunrise, students have access to programs that focus heavily on college career readiness through programs like ACE's retreat, First Gen and one on one Advising

FAFSA TIPS

Both you and your parents should document your FAFSA passwords since you will have two different accounts and will need them for all 4 years of college During their senior year, scholars participate in workshops during Senior Sunrise to focus on each step of the college application process. Programming includes college-list creation, FAFSA nights, and early application workshops. After applying to their college list schools, scholars may also participate in programs related to the college-experience such as the ACE Retreat (Activate, Cultivate, Elevate) and Attollo First-Gen.





Attollo First Gen is a cohort of students who identify as the first in their family (not including siblings) to go to a four-year institution. Programming includes networking opportunities, student panels, and college readiness. Programs will occur throughout the academic year.





Attollo ACEs is a weekend retreat that focuses on college-readiness and professional/personal development. ACEs will entail workshops regarding topics such as student life, mental health and financial/academic success. ACEs seeks to bring in young professionals and college students to attend panel discussions, providing first hand experiences to our scholars. ACEs seniors will ultimately gain skills that will provide them with the opportunity to do an internship or shadowship with a local company for the remainder of their senior year.


SDC

The Student Diplomacy Corps (SDC) creates opportunities for underserved high school students from across the nation to access dynamic international education summer programs that build college readiness, deepen empathy and unleash the potential of youth. This year, 9 students were selected to participate summer experiences both domestically and abroad.

NHI

The National Hispanic Institute was founded in 1979 and annually serves between 2,000-2,500 students. To date, NHI has served over 100,000 students and works with 80 colleges and universities. NHI's mission is to create experiences that engage achieving high school and college age youth in community leadership roles that advance our quality of life. This year, 7 ATTOLLO scholars participated in a weekend long retreat at St.Mary's College.
